

## Sonoma County 2023-2024 4-H Youth Member Enrollment Process For 4-H Program Year: July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024 Revised January, 2024

Youth are eligible to participate in 4-H if they meet the following criteria:

- <u>Primary Member</u>: Must be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2023. Youth who turn 9 on or after January 1, 2024 must participate as a primary member until the end of the program year.
- <u>Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Members:</u> Must be 9 years old on or before December 31, 2023. Youth may join if they are not 19 years old on or before December 31, 2023. Youth who turn 19 and who are already a 4-H member may continue capstone activities through December 31, 2024.

#### **Enrollment Steps**

- 1. Complete Enrollment Survey
- 2. Submit 4-H youth member enrollment online at https://4h.zsuite.org/
  - a. <u>New Member</u>: Create a family profile, create a new youth enrollment, enter all information, and submit. 4hOnline status will show as awaiting review.
  - <u>Returning Member</u>: <u>Do not create a new duplicate account!</u>
    If you have participated in 4-H between 2018 and 2023, you are a returning member. Reset your password via your email.
    If you aren't sure if you are a returning member, contact <u>Miguel Delgado</u>
  - c. Select Club "Brooks 4-H Afterschool Club" Select Project "ECC MARK WEST - Winter STEM Project"
- 3. The survey entry and Zsuite enrollment are reviewed by the County 4-H Office. When approved, notification of your 4-H youth member will be sent from 4hOnline along with more information regarding the 4-H program at your school site.
