Sonoma County 4-H ignites the spark of possibility in youth, ages 5 to 18, helping them thrive in developing leadership & public speaking skills, a passion for learning, personal development, and motivation to reach their full potential, while making a positive impact in their community.

4-H CLUBS In 17 chartered 4-H community clubs, youth lead, learn, and serve, gaining lifelong knowledge, leadership skills, honing their responsibility and public speaking skills while serving the community.

4-H CAMP 150+ youth lived in the outdoors during one of two weeks of sleep-away camps, honing new skills, gaining environmental knowledge, and building relationships to last a lifetime.

4-H EXPANDED LEARNING Sonoma 4-H grew, by partnering with organizations to provide STEM, arts, athletics, and environmental programs. Notably, 50 youth attended the Tinker Academies, 150 youth joined the 4-H soccer league, and more than 10,000 people attended the North Bay Science Discovery Day.
