



Stanislaus County 4-H Horse Group

State Fair OR Classic Horse Show Sponsorship Application

Purpose: In an effort for Stanislaus County to be represented by the 4-H members that are eligible to attend the State Fair OR Classic Horse Show, this scholarship was created to assist with the cost of attending these events.

In alignment with the 4-H Mission Statement, this award will support the basic goals of our 4-H Horse Group Members.

The mission of 4-H is to help young people develop their potential. This is done by encouraging them to participate in practical real-life experiences. As a result of this involvement, they should be better able to lead satisfying lives as responsible, self-directing, members of society.

Award Components: The Stanislaus County Horse Leaders Group and one Member of the County Board, will select ten [10] recipients, using up to a \$1,000.00 budget each member will receive up to \$100 or more depending on the amount that qualify, that rewards members for meeting the eligibility requirements to attend the State Fair OR Classic Horse Show.

Award Impact: Each year, approximately thirty [30] members will represent Stanislaus County at the highest level of Horsemanship.

Award Criteria:

1. Applicant must be in active standing within their Community 4-H Group and Horse Group
2. Applicant must have completed Level 1 at Achievement Day
3. Applicant must have qualified at a County Fair or Classic qualifying horse show.
- 4. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is June 30th, 4:30 p.m. (No exceptions).**
5. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
2. The member's Horse Leader must sign the completed application. If application is completed online and emailed, please have your leader email their approval to amybruno2015@outlook.com .
6. Applicant must agree to follow all 4-H safety requirements at either State or Classic Events, to continue representing Stanislaus County at it's best.

Deadline for the application is June 30th. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered. Emailed applications will be accepted. Please email to to amybruno2015@outlook.com

Special Provision: Scholarship funds will be presented upon completion of presentation at Horse Leaders Meeting. State Fair or Classic Sponsorship is up to \$100 and at the discretion of the committee, failure to attend either the State Fair or Classic Horse Show, will result in no funds being issued. Scholarship funds are for current year State Fair Best of Show or current year California 4-H Horse Classic only.
