





 & self-control
- Supervise campers responsibly with patience & a sense of humor
- Participate in the Area Activity alongside campers with a passionate & positive attitude

The volleyball court is your domain! "Laser" light (yarn) obstacle course was pretty popular a few years ago-be creative!


Campfire:

TEEN STAFF RECRUITMENT!

Leadership Positions:



The Campfire Director is responsible for:

- Nightly entertainment schedule
- Stage decorations
- In-depth session activities

The Campfire Director should seek input from and share responsibilities with the campfire area **team.**

Kitchen Assistants/Engineers:

New for 2024 we are seeking 2 candidates to share the following responsibilities:

- Food Preparation
- Oversee Dining Hall clean-up at each meal
- Oversee dishwashing at every meal
- Help adult staff with cooking/food prep dishes.
- Kitchen/Dining Hall trash duty

Camp Engineers: (1 Male & 1 Female)

Camp engineers share the following responsibilities:

- Random engineer-type duties
- Supervise bathroom chores
- Dust suppression
- Trash Duty

Cabin Coordinators: (1 Male & 1 Female) Cabin coordinators share the following responsibilities:

• Cabin assignments

- Chore schedule
- Cabin Counselor Support
- Conflict Management



Youth Directors: (Typically 1 Male & 1 Female)

Youth Directors share the following responsibilities:

- Lead camp planning sessions.
- Support all members of your teen staff team.
- Administer camp schedule, perform role call, and perform conflict management as necessary.
- Lead the teen staff and campers with a positive attitude and role model the behavior you expect from the teen staff and campers.
