Checklist

Introductory Information

- { } Title Page including the club's name, the officer's name and the club year.
- { } Table of Contents
- { } Personal statement by officer. Should describe what the Reporter did during the year, and be signed by the Club Community Leader.

Announcements

- { } Announcements of club meetings and other club events written and submitted by the club reporter to the newspaper, including unpublished articles, organized month by month.*

Club-Hosted Event Articles

- { } Articles of club-hosted or other 4-H events written and submitted by the club reporter to the newspaper, including unpublished articles, organized chronologically.*

Club-Level Publications

- { } Club Newsletters or other material written and produced by the club reporter for the benefit of club members, organized chronologically.

Radio & Television

- { } List of appearances of the club on Radio or Television. List should include the station and the date of the appearance.

Non-Reporter Articles

- { } Articles published about the club and members/events thereof, not written or submitted by the club reporter, organized chronologically.* **Articles in this section must include the club's name in the text, and the subject material must be directly related to the 4-H Youth Development Program.**

*The publications name and date should appear with all news clippings.
