Enrollment deadline is November 8th. Please know that each club may close enrollments on or before this date in order submit all required forms to the 4-H office on November 8, 2021.

Enrollment fees: \$65 youth (5 to 19 yrs.) Adult volunteers: \$30

Enrollment fees are discounted to \$50 for the first 450 members to register or until October 15th, whichever is reached first.

•Make sure to add current contact information, including an email address. The County 4-H office contacts members via email for any updates and to share important information.

•Enter all important information, including ethnicity questions. This information is for data collecting purposes for our county.

Please know that no parent is obligated to register in order for their child to participate in the 4-H organization.
