2018 Statewide 4-H Teen Staff Camp Evaluation

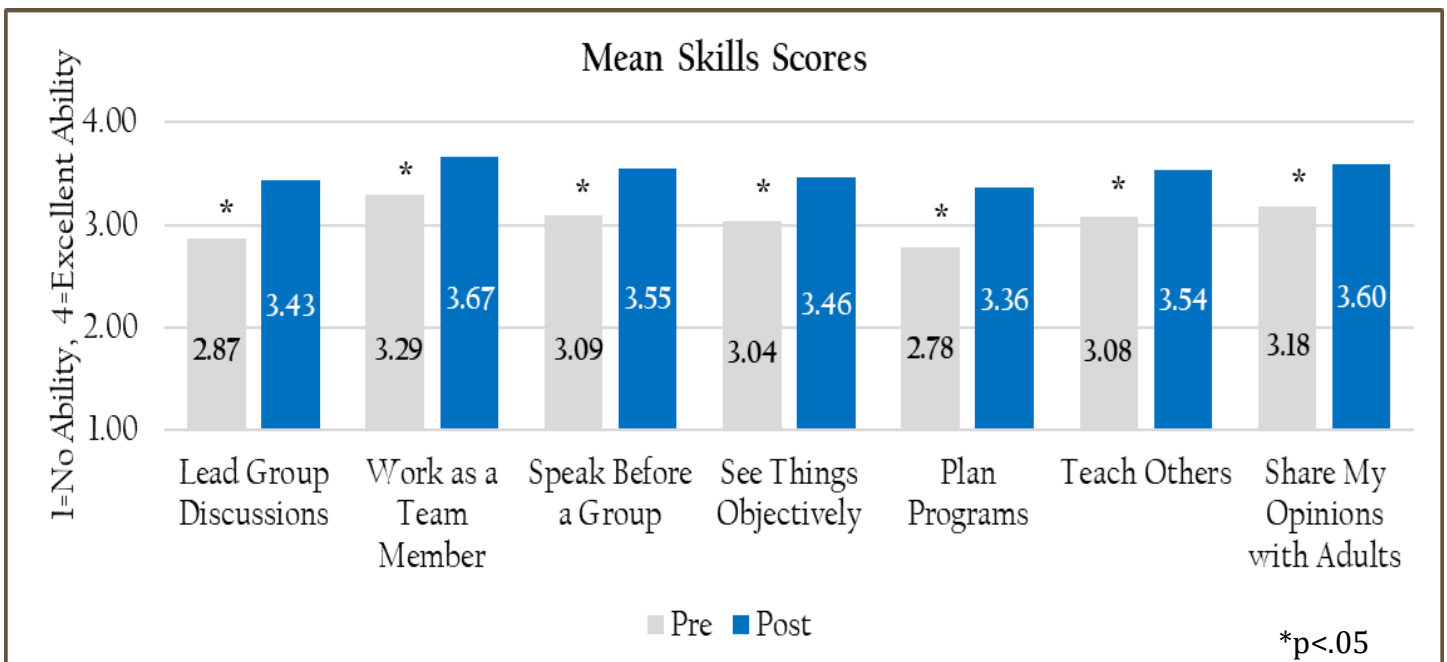
In 2018, 17 camps participated in evaluation and asked teen staff about their experience. This report summarizes the results of the evaluation statewide.



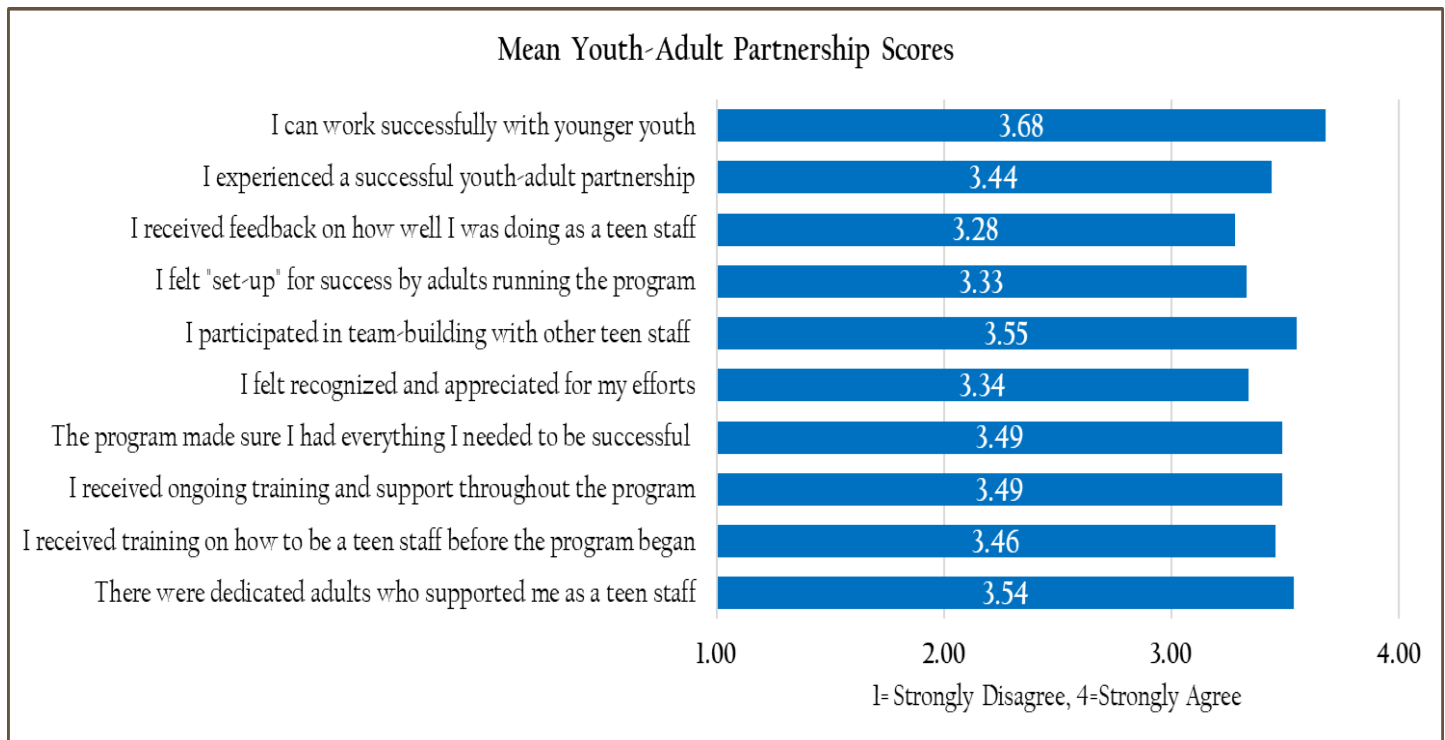
All about the teen staff

% Boys	44%
% Girls	56%
Average age (in years)	15.89

After camp ended, teens reported on their skills before (pre) and after (post) camp. Results showed that teens felt they grew in all the skills assessed.



Teens also reflected on the youth-adult partnerships they experienced as a camp staff. Presented are the means for each question.
