Teaching Beginning Farmers. Over 140 farmers and ranchers participated in beginning farming classes. A new UC Foothill Farming website provides additional support.

Keeping Farming and Ranching Viable. A six-week farm business planning class was held to help producers plan for profitability.

Providing Home Horticulture Information. Master Gardener programs gave 49 workshops, 20 community events, and provided 10,000 hours of volunteer service.

Helping Reduce Obesity in Local Youth. 4,000 low income Placer & Nevada County school children received nutrition education through UCCE developed curriculum.

Creating Tomorrows Leaders. Over 250 youth served as officers or teen leaders in their 4-H community clubs.

Volunteering Community Services. 4-H clubs provided 260 community service activities and 4-H adult volunteers provided 39,000 hours of support.
