Become a Master Gardener!

UCCE Ventura County offers the Master Gardener training class every two years. We are preparing for the Class of 2024. To start the application process, go to <https://ucanr.edu/sites/VCMG/> to choose a date and time to attend a mandatory Information Meeting.

Master Gardener trainee requirements:

- Receive fingerprint clearance from the California Department of Justice.
- Successfully complete the 20-week training class with no more than 2 sessions of non-attendance.
- Complete a 20-hour Hands-On Project.
- Pass a final exam with at least 70% accuracy.

Upon graduation:

- Accrue at least 50 volunteer hours to support education programs and demonstration gardens.
