
Travel Restrictions: State Funds

*Travel to Nebraska using state funds will be prohibited after 10/01/23

Travel Restrictions: State Funds

- AB 1887 prohibits a state agency, department, board, or commission from requiring any state employees, officers, or members to travel to a state that, after June 26, 2015, has enacted a law that
 - (1) has the effect of voiding or repealing existing state or local protections against discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression;
 - (2) authorizes or requires discrimination against same-sex couples or their families or on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression; or
 - (3) creates an exemption to antidiscrimination laws in order to permit discrimination against same-sex couples or their families or on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression. (Gov. Code, § 11139.8, subds. (b)(1), (2).)
- In addition, the law prohibits California from approving a request for state-funded or statesponsored travel to such a state. (Gov. Code, § 11139.8, subd. (b)(2).)

Travel Restrictions: Federal Funds

• Fly America Act - U.S. carriers must be used for travel reimbursed from federal funds e.g. contracts & grants

Note: "code share" flights are allowed. The flight may be on a non-domestic air carrier's plane when a U.S. carrier's 2-letter code is recorded next to the flight number (ex: DL 388 identifies the flight as Delta Airlines).

Travel Restrictions: Federal Funds

- Exceptions:
 - Short distance flight time is less than 3 hours
 - Extends travel time by 24 hours or more
 - When nonstop or direct service is unavailable from a US carrier; and
 - · Increases aircraft changes by two or more
 - Extends travel time by 6 hours
 - Requires connecting travel time of four hours or more
 - Eligible "Open Skies Agreements" for:
 - European union
 - Australia
 - Switzerland
 - Japan

Note: Canada does not have an Open Skies Agreement
