

Project Skills Showcase FAQ

Purpose:

To provide volunteers access to a broad range of research-based, high-quality, interesting and diverse project ideas to enhance youth engagement and programming at the local level.

Why The Showcase?

In past conferences, participants have had to choose which project skills workshop they wished to attend often missing out on opportunities that would have added value to their volunteer experience and increased youth engagement in local programming. The Project Skills Showcase is designed to give all participants access to all resources in an exhibit environment where people are free to roam from booth-to-booth and gain the knowledge and skills necessary to bring tools home with them.

What Should a Showcase Booth Include?

Approved booths will include a clear focus area based on the California 4-H Project List (download here) and either highlight a new research-based curriculum or a specific learn-bydoing activity. Handouts, interactive activities, and swag is encouraged.

How It Works

Those who register for The Leaders Retreat and stay at Asilomar will receive a FREE Showcase booth if their proposal is approved. Those attending the Friday, pre-retreat workshops will have early access to set up their booths and interact with participants and extended evening hours on Saturday night until 8pm.

Those who ONLY wish to participate in the Project Skills Showcase on Saturday, November 9, 2019 will pay a \$200 per person registration fee which will include your booth, access to the keynote speaker address, participation in the Showcase, and lunch for the day. The Showcase will function as a separate workshop option throughout the entire day of the gathering.
