

## How to enroll in 4-H for the 2022-2023 program year:

New members will need to create an account. Then Create a "Family" or join a "Family" that already exists if you had a sibling that was already a member.

Sign-up for all the projects that you are interested in taking, they all happen at different times of the year. If you can't make it to the project, please let the project leader know when they email you about the project meetings.

Please make sure all of your information is current and up to date, and that all parts of the enrollment are filled out.
