Speaker Bio: Dr. Erica Siirila-Woodburn is a Research Scientist in the Earth and Environmental Sciences Area at Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory studying above-and-below-ground connections in the water cycle in the face of climate change, with a focus on computational hydrology. Her work includes studying how shifts in precipitation patterns, climate extremes, wildfires, and land cover change impact water partitioning. Erica holds a PhD and MS in hydrology from the Colorado School of Mines, a BA in geology from the University of Colorado at Boulder, and spent two years at the Polytechnic Institute of Barcelona for a postdoctoral fellowship before joining LBNL in 2015.
