To exhibit either an animal or still exhibit in a 4-H Division at the 2025 Colusa County Fair, 4-H members must meet the requirements set by the UC 4-H Steps to Success, as well as the following requirements set by the Colusa County 4-H Council and 4-H Professional Staff:		
1.	Complete 4-H enrollment for a Colusa County 4-H Club, pay enrollment fee to the Club, and have this form submitted to your Club Leader by October 1, 2024.	
2.	Attend a minimum of six (6) hours of project meetings (of those projects which will be exhibited at the fair). a. More meetings may be required at the Project Leader's discretion. b. Project meetings can be made up at the Project Leader's discretion.	
3.	LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS: Attend one (1) educational event <i>related to your project</i> .* a. Youth exhibiting livestock must attend a livestock or animal science related event.** b. Events may include CSU, Chico Swine Day, CSU Chico Sheep Day, Small Animal Field Day	
4.	STILL EXHIBITORS: Attend one (1) educational event <i>related to your project.</i> * a. Youth exhibiting a still exhibit must attend an event related to still exhibits. b. Events may include Still Exhibits Day, Fashion Revue, Craft Expo	
5.	Complete one (1) presentation related to your project at a. Presentation opportunities include***: • Project meetings (as allowed by Club and Project Club Meetings (as allowed by Club and Project County Presentation Day • Arbuckle 4-H Presentation Night • Council Meetings (allowed with prior arrangeme) • Craft Expo (must actively teach a craft, attendar	ct Leader) Leader) nt)
6. Complete an Annual Project Report (APR) for the project(s) being exhibited.*		
*If you are exhibiting both a livestock project and a still exhibit project, then you must attend an appropriate Field Day and complete an APR for each. **Jackpots are not eligible educational events, per UC 4-H Policy. ***Presentations given at school are not eligible for this requirement.
