♦ **WHY:** Learn about your local watersheds and collect data that provides a "snapshot" in time of water quality and stream conditions.

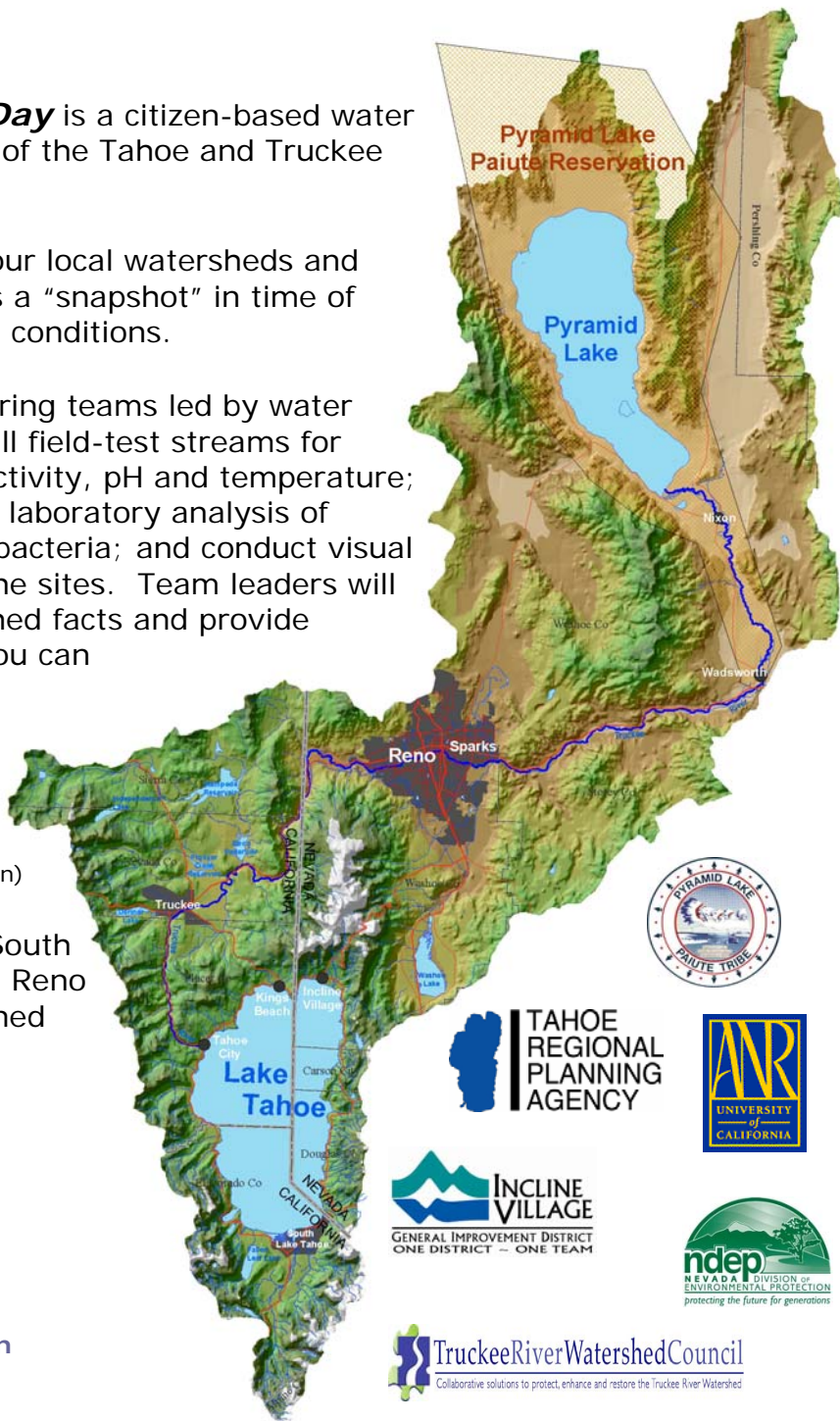

Team leaders will share interesting watershed facts and provide information about how you can improve and protect your watershed.
