Sheet Mulching Techniques - How and Why

Sheet mulching can suppress weed grow th and/or replace a law n, improve nutrient and water retention in the soil, encourage favorable soil microbial activity and worms, enhance soil structure, and improve plant vigor and health, all of which will often lead to improved resistance to pests and diseases. Registration required.
