Club Historian Book – Requirements for Club Seals

Book can be in ANY format – they can be generated and printed on-line or hand scrapbooked or printed on the computer. Books should be a record of your club and the activities participated in for the year.

Clubs need to consider the cost of the production of the book whether printed or hand scrapbooked. They also need to recognize the necessities of all members in the club to participate in the process even though the final responsibility may be with one club Historian officer. Historian books are to be reflective of the club and the club in turn receives the credit for the book. WOW officer books will be awarded a prize that will be received by the Club and a pin that is received by the Historian. This is to acknowledge the involvement of all.

Clubs are to submit Historian books with an evaluation sheet they complete. They are to add lines as needed. Please list all the pages in the category YOU intend them to be credited in. Judges will verify the judging sheet and select one overall WOW county winner. Clubs will also each receive an individual seal based on the seal criteria.

Historians are encouraged to include pages of activities and event in which their club participated. **Pages without club members participating in the pictures will not be credited as “pages.”** So, pictures must include members from the club, pictures without members from the club will not be credited. The list below are ONLY suggestions! Think about what your club has done and document accordingly.

The purpose of the County, Area, State and National requirements are to encourage clubs to think about what they do beyond their own local sphere of influence. We hope to encourage clubs to participate in the world beyond their own clubs, and document it.

As always... Members can seek out a CIRC committee member to answer questions or even complete a preliminary check of their book while in the design stage. We are all here to help members be successful.

So have fun documenting the memories your club has made this year!!
