TO HELP DETERMINE WHERE SUNNY SPOTS IN LANDSCAPE WILL BE

Each month (at midnight, during a full moon) wherever the moonlight falls is where (at noon in 6 months) the sunlight will fall (**Prof John Charlesworth, NVC**)

See below for examples:

MOONLIGHT=SUNLIGHT

JANUARY=JULY	JULY=JANUARY
FEBRUARY=AUGUST	AUGUST=FEBRUARY
MARCH=SEPTEMBER	SEPTEMBER=MARCH
APRIL=OCTOBER	OCTOBER=APRIL
MAY=NOVEMBER	NOVEMBER=MAY
JUNE=DECEMBER	DECEMBER=JUNE

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
