DECEMBER Vegetable Planting Guide

December is the month to start researching and planning for bareroot perennial vegetables, which are usually available the end of December, January, and February. In designing the vegetable garden adequate growing area needs to be set aside on a permanent basis so that the perennials develop and produce a crop year after year. Not every garden has room for perennials, a healthy artichoke can cover an area up to four feet by four feet. Perennial vegetables can also be planted into ornamental beds. Important considerations when adding perennial vegetables to the ornamental garden is making sure there is adequate sun exposure and ease of harvest. Many of them have interesting foliage or flowers.
