Dear 4-H Volunteer,

Thank you for volunteering to help serve at the Farm Bureau Crab Feed on **Saturday, January 17, 2026**. Please arrive between 5:00 and 5:30 p.m. in the cafeteria (across from the Grandstands) at the Glenn County Fairgrounds. When you check in with the 4-H liaison, you will receive your name tag and a colored bandana, which will coordinate with the row of tables you will serve during the evening.

A pizza dinner will be provided for volunteers before serving begins, so please arrive on time to enjoy it and be ready for your duties. It is important to be on your best behavior and maintain a neat, presentable appearance. Many people attending the Farm Bureau Crab Feed Dinner are generous supporters of the 4-H Program, and we want to represent 4-H with pride and professionalism.

Glenn County Farm Bureau asks that you wear a white, button-up, collared shirt with clean denim pants. We will provide serving gloves and aprons for each member and adult. Please leave your 4-H hat and scarf/tie at home to avoid them being misplaced. Comfortable, closed-toe shoes are recommended, as you will be on your feet for much of the evening.

Parent volunteers and 4-H members are expected to follow proper food safety practices, including wearing gloves, avoiding touching food with bare hands, washing hands with soap and water, and keeping hair restrained while serving.

You will be responsible for serving food, washing dishes, and cleaning tables after dinner. It is essential to stay for the whole duration of your assignment until cleanup is complete, and the 4-H liaison has checked you out. Please note that duties may conclude as late as 10:00 p.m. or later.

Thank you again for volunteering your time and effort to serve at the Glenn County Farm Bureau Crab Feed. Your help has a positive impact and proudly represents 4-H in our community.
