Introduction to the Event:

The Glenn County 4-H Fundraiser Dinner and Bake Sale is a fun County-wide event that invites the community to participate on the first Saturday in March, serving pork loin, salad, rice, roll, and a drink. The Fundraiser Dinner not only includes dinner but also a kids' carnival and a bake sale. The Fundraiser Dinner is the largest fundraiser of the year for our 4-H youth development program, and all proceeds benefit events, awards, and trainings for the 4-H youth. Families are asked to contribute a homemade dessert to the bake sale. There is also an option to participate in the Battle of the Bakers competition at the event. 4-H Adult Volunteers and 4-H Members are asked to sign up online for various shifts.

Who?

Any 4-H members and Adult Volunteers. The community is also invited to purchase tickets to attend the dinner.

When?

How?

4-H Adult Volunteers and members are asked to sign up online for various shifts. Shifts involve setup, cleanup, serving food, assisting members of our community, collecting tickets, helping with to-go orders, volunteering at the bake sale, and assisting with the carnival. 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What do I Wear?

Clean attire is required. You will be provided with a Glenn County 4-H apron. If you are serving or around food, you will be asked to have your hair pulled back. Some youth members wear their 4-H uniform, and that is acceptable.

What do I do When I Arrive?

Check in at the entrance of Memorial Hall. This is where you will sign in, grab a 4-H apron, and be provided instruction and guidance.

What is the Bake Sale?

The Bake Sale will take place during the Fundraiser Dinner. Customers will have the opportunity to purchase desserts through donations. The “Battle of the Bakers” cake, cupcake, and cookie decorating contest will take place during the fundraiser dinner. All desserts will be available for guests to purchase through donation.



Do you have to compete in the Battle of the Bakers?

No. You can donate a dessert without being included in the competition. All desserts are sold through donations.

How do I enter in the Battle of the Bakers?

All dessert entries need to be brought to the UCCE Office by **Friday, March 6, 2026**, by 5:00 p.m., or they can be brought to Willows Memorial Hall on **Saturday, March 7, 2026**, by 1:30 p.m. to be included in the Battle of the Bakers contest.

Awards and Recognition?

Fundraiser Dinner Ticket Sales Competition - incentives to sell and participate.

Top Club Seller: If the Top Club Seller is also the Top County Seller, the 2nd place winner will then move up and be awarded 1st place, Top Club Seller, and so on. All club top ticket sellers must sell a minimum of 20 tickets each to qualify.

- 1st place will receive a \$75.00 gift card and a 2026 Glenn County Fair Ride Pass.
- 2nd place will receive a \$50 gift card and a 4-H t-shirt.
- 3rd place will receive a \$25 gift card.

Top County Seller will receive a \$100.00 gift card, a 2026 Glenn County Fair Ride Pass, and a 4-H t-shirt. The top county ticket seller must sell a minimum of 30 tickets to qualify.

4-H Clubs will earn \$1.00 from each ticket sold by their club members. 4-H clubs will get to choose what to do with this income for their club!



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Battle of the Bakers Competition: Certificates and participation ribbons will be awarded to all primary members. 1st through 3rd place will be awarded in each age division, Junior, Intermediate, Senior, and Adults. Prizes will include gift cards. Prizes awarded as follows:

- 1st place will receive a \$75.00 gift card.
- 2nd place will receive a \$50.00 gift card.
- 3rd place will receive a \$25.00 gift card.
