Inspect vines for VMB at the graft union and under the wax layer.
Quite la cera y revise debajo, buscando el piojo harinoso de la vid (VMB).



Inspect all flats in each shipment for VMB. Inspect 2 to 4 vines per flat.
*Revise todas las bandejas en cada envío de vides verdes.
Revise 2 a 4 plantas por bandeja.*
