WHAT'S NEW

- **Market Lamb Classes Added** - Market lambs will be split into Black Face (BFX), White/Brockle Face, and Natural (Blue)
- **Market Hog Classes Added** - Market hogs will be split into registered and unregistered classes.
- **Market Beef - Market Heifers** qualify as "Market Beef" and will compete in the same class.
- **New Location - Jr. Show Ring & Livestock Barns (SEE MAP)**
- **New this year - ROUND ROBIN!**
- **No pens this year - All Exhibitors are encouraged to use your trailer as your pen for this event.**

(If your exhibit will *need* a pen, you will be responsible for setup Friday night and clean-up immediately following showing. No exceptions.)

EVENT RULES

CHECK IN BEGINS AT 8:30AM - SCALES OPEN AT 9:00AM

****ANIMALS THAT ARE NOT WEIGHED IN 30 MINUTES MIN. PRIOR TO SHOWTIME WILL NOT SHOW**

- Primary 4-H members, ages 5-8, may show in the Primary Showmanship class only (Nigerian Dwarf Goat). Ages are as of December 31, 2025.
- All livestock entered must be currently owned and cared for by the exhibitor under the direct supervision of a certified 4-H leader.
- Do not bring animals that have been or may be sick - show management reserves the right to remove unacceptable animals
- All animals will be health checked during weigh-in.
- All exhibitors must be supervised by an instructor/leader or designated adult.
- An exhibitor must show (handle) his/her own animal. If more than one animal is entered, another current 4-H member, 9 years old and up, may assist by showing the extra animal.
- Long pants and appropriate footwear (closed-toes shoes or boots) are required in all livestock classes. Sleeveless shirts and bare midriffs are not allowed. Exhibitors may wear their 4-H uniform but it is not required for participation. Uniforms are not a criterion in judging.
- Exhibitors may not serve as clerks/youth co-judges for any division they have entered.
- The exhibitor is responsible for meeting check-in and judging times. Exhibitors and livestock must be ready when classes are called. Late exhibits will not be judged.

The 4-H staff and/or show management will not be responsible for unattended or unclaimed animals

Event Rules specific to Market Animals:

All market animals entered are **LIMITED to Tehama County 4-H members ONLY** and should be intended for the exclusive purpose of exhibition at the **2026 Tehama District Fair**.

Market classes will be divided by weight at the discretion of show management.

DIVISION A: SWINE

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation/Market Class
3. Market Classes are limited to Tehama County 4-H Exhibitors ONLY
4. All Breeds judged together
5. **Young Swine MUST be weaned**
6. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own fighting boards.
7. Blue ribbons from each weight break in Class 8 advance to final round of Class 8.

CLASS 4: Conformation, Gilts 6mo and under

CLASS 5: Conformation, Gilts/Sows Fall or Jr Yearlings (Jan 25-Dec 25)

CLASS 6: Conformation, Gilts/Sows Yearling, over 1, not yet 2 years old

CLASS 7: PUREBRED/REGISTERED Market Swine; broken by weight

DIVISION B: DAIRY CATTLE

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation Classes
3. All Breeds judged together
4. **Young Swine MUST be weaned**

CLASS 4: Conformation, Calves (Sept 25-2026)

CLASS 5: Conformation, Yearlings (Sept 24-Aug 25)

CLASS 6: Conformation, (Sept 2024-Prior)

DIVISION C: BEEF

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation/Market Class
3. Market Classes are limited to Tehama County 4-H Exhibitors ONLY
4. All Breeds judged together
5. Blue ribbons from each weight break in Class 8 advance to final round of Class 8.

CLASS 3: Showmanship, age 14 ^

CLASS 4: Conformation, Junior Heifer Calf; 0-4 mos

CLASS 5: Conformation, Senior Heifer Calf; 5-8 mos

CLASS 6: Conformation, Yearling Heifer, over 9 mos

CLASS 7: Cow/Calf Pair - Calf must be prodigy of Cow

CLASS 8: Market Steer & Commercial Heifers; broken by weight

DIVISION D: SHEEP

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation/Market Class
3. Market Classes are limited to Tehama County 4-H Exhibitors ONLY
4. All Breeds judged together *EXCEPT MARKET*
5. Blue ribbons from each weight break in Class 8 advance to final round of Class 8.

CLASS 4: Conformation, Ewe lambs; 0-6 mos

CLASS 7: Conformation, Ewes 2 years and older

CLASS 8: Conformation, Ram lambs 0-2yrs

CLASS 9: Conformation, Ram lambs 2 years and older

CLASS 10: Market Sheep; by Breed (BFX, White, Natural) then weight

DIVISION E: MEAT GOAT

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation/Market Class
3. Market Classes are limited to Tehama County 4-H Exhibitors ONLY
4. All Breeds judged together
5. Blue ribbons from each weight break in Class 8 advance to final round of Class 8.

DIVISION F: DAIRY GOAT

1. Limit of one (1) entry for Showmanship
2. Limit of two (2) entries per Conformation/Market Class
3. Market Classes are limited to Tehama County 4-H Exhibitors ONLY
4. All Breeds judged together
5. 4-H Primary Members 5-8 years old are permitted in Class 1 ONLY, NO JUDGING

CLASS 1: Showmanship, **4-H Primary Members ONLY**; Nigerian Dwarf Goat

CLASS 2: Showmanship, age 9-10

CLASS 3: Showmanship, age 11-13

CLASS 4: Showmanship, age 14 ^

CLASS 5: Conformation, Doe Kids; 0-3 mos

CLASS 6: Conformation, Doe Kids; 4-6 mos

CLASS 7: Conformation, non-milking Senior Doe, over 6 mos

CLASS 8: Conformation, milking Doe, 1-2 years

CLASS 9: Conformation, milking Doe, 3 years

CLASS 10: Conformation, milking Doe, 4 years and up

CLASS 11: Conformation, Bucks, 0-24 mos

DIVISION R: ROUND ROBIN
