“Outstanding 4-H Sheep Project Member of the Year”

All 4-H members currently enrolled in a 4-H Sheep Project are eligible to apply. **Applications are due by April 10th, 2026 by 5PM** to the 4-H Office, 1754 Walnut St., Red Bluff, CA 96080. **No postmarks or late applications will be accepted.** Two individuals will be recognized annually. The 1st place member’s name will be placed on a perpetual plaque, and they will receive \$100 cash award and an individual trophy. The 2nd place member will receive an individual trophy. The selection committee will review the 4-H members’ application and critique their Tehama District Fair participation.

- Sheep Project Leadership (30);
- Sheep project has shown growth in size and scope (15);
- Shares sheep knowledge and skills with others (20);
- Participates at countywide sheep events and activities (20);
- Sheep exhibit(s) at this year’s Tehama District Fair (15);
- FFA and other organization’s achievements may be listed but will not be considered.
