





















	<b>Aster, Maryland Chrysopsis mariana</b>	2-3'. Tough aster with yellow daisy flowers. Drought tolerant and has the best deer resistance of all asters. Give it room as it will spread. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Aster, New York Aster novi-belgii (Symphyotrichum)</b>	3-6'. Beautiful small violet/purple double-daisy flowers cover the stems in late summer and fall. Prune to about 18". It will spread, so give it room. Some deer resistance. Attracts bees & butterflies. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Bay Laurel, California Umbellularia californica</b>	45'. Evergreen NATIVE tree. Fragrant leaves with culinary uses. Yellow flowers, green berries. Deer resistant/drought tolerant. Okay in clay soil. Full sun/part shade.
	<b>Beardtongue Penstemon digitalis 'Mystica'</b>	3'. Spikes of large, soft lavender-pink flowers. Butterfly and hummingbird magnets. Best leaf color: green to bronze and red shades when in full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Bee Balm, Scarlet Monarda didyma</b>	2-3'. Herb with showy scarlet flower clusters. As its name implies, the bees love these flowers as well as hummingbirds and butterflies. Reseeds and spreads. Deer resistant. Full sun. A Master Gardener favorite. Perennial.
	<b>Bee Balm, Wild, Bergamot Monarda fistulosa</b>	3-4'. Pink-lavender florets. Summer-to-fall blooming. Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies, and pollinators. Deer resistant/drought tolerant. Edible. Full sun/part shade. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Bellflower, Blue Dwarf Campanula collina</b>	1'. Low-mounding green foliage is topped with foot-long blue bell-shaped flower spikes in spring. A tough deer-resistant plant that is not too fussy about soil quality. Full sun/afternoon shade. Perennial.
	<b>Bellflower, Clustered Campanula glomerata</b>	2'. Dense clusters of purple bell-shaped flowers appear in late spring through early summer. Deadhead to promote re-blooming. Deer resistant. Full sun/part shade. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Bellflower, Tussock Campanula carpatica</b>	1'. Blue balloon-shaped flowers bloom continuously from early summer to late fall. Perfect in front of the flower border. Deer/rabbit resistant. Full sun/part shade. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Black-eyed Susan Rudbeckia hirta 'Indian Summer'</b>	3-3.5'. Single-double 6-9" yellow flowers with brown centers from summer to frost. Excellent cut flower. Deer resistant. Attracts pollinators and butterflies. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!

	<b>Brown-eyed Susan</b> <i>Rudbeckia triloba</i>	4-5'. Sunny yellow flowers with black centers. Easy to grow, drought tolerant once established. Deer resistant. Pollinator plant. Reseeds. Wonderful in flower arrangements. Full sun. Short-lived perennial.
	<b>Blackberry, Thornless</b> <i>Rubus Canadensis</i>	4-8'. These deciduous vines will produce luscious blackberries all summer without the ouch! Moderate deer resistance. Grow in full sun on a trellis. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Bleeding Heart, Fringed</b> <i>Dicentra formosa</i>	12-18". Lovely bleeding heart tolerates sun & warm temperatures better than most Dicentra. Fern-like foliage with heart-shaped pink/red flowers. Deer resistant. Part shade. Toxic. Perennial.
	<b>Bluebeard</b> <i>Caryopteris x clanonensis 'Blue Mist'</i>	2-3'. Deciduous shrub with long-blooming blue flowers. Very tough plant. Pollinator plant. Deer-resistant/rabbit resistant/drought tolerant. Full sun.
	<b>Borage</b> <i>Borago officinalis</i>	1-3'. Herb (reseeds) with dainty, vivid blue flowers. Pollinator plant. Some deer resistance. Full sun/part shade. Toxic. Annual.
	<b>Brown-eyed Susan</b> <i>Rudbeckia triloba</i>	3-5'. A tough plant. Green foliage is covered in yellow flowers with brown centers. Great rudbeckia! Drought tolerant/deer resistant. Reseeds. Full sun. Short-lived perennial.
	<b>Buckwheat, California</b> <i>Eriogonum fasciculatum</i>	1-5' NATIVE. Tough, easy to grow. Shrub has a spreading form with fuzzy pinkish-white flowers. A tough pollinator plant. Very drought tolerant. Deer resistant. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Butterfly Bush</b> <i>Buddleia x weyerigna 'Honeycomb'</i>	12'. Easy to grow deciduous shrub. Long lasting creamy yellow flowers with orange centers. Flowers from June to Sept. Pollinator plant. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	<b>Cactus, Queen of the Night</b> <i>Epiphyllum oxypetalum</i>	8-10'. This stunning night-blooming succulent has white orchid-like flowers. Grow indoors in bright indirect light as a houseplant or outside when the temperature stays above 40F. Part shade. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>California Fuchsia</b> <i>Epilobium canum</i>	15-30". A NATIVE small shrub for dry gardens and hillsides. Requires no summer water once established. Late summer and fall bloom with scarlet-red trumpet flowers. Silvery-green foliage. Drought tolerant/deer resistant. Full sun. Perennial.











	<p><b>Camas</b> <b>Camassia quamash</b></p>	<p>1-2'. Native bulb is considered a herb. Gorgeous blue-purple upright flowers in late spring to early summer. Pollinator plant. Deer/rabbit resistant. Full sun/part shade. Naturalizes well. Perennial.</p>
	<p><b>Canterbury Bells</b> <b>Campanula medium</b> <b>'Calycathema'</b></p>	<p>18-36". 1"-2" long, bell-shaped flowers in purple, violet, blue, lavender, pink, and white blossoms cover tall flower spikes. This dramatic, tall plant is an excellent backdrop for your shorter annuals and perennials, blooms into early summer, attracts pollinators, and is a wonderful, long-lasting cut flower! Full sun/part shade. Biennial.</p>
	<p><b>Catmint</b> <b>Nepeta faassenii 'Walker's Low'</b></p>	<p>18-24". Mounding catmint with long bloom time of lovely lavender-blue flowers. Low water, deer/rabbit resistant, great pollinator plant. Full sun. Perennial.</p>
	<p><b>Cedar, California Incense</b> <b>Calocedrus decurrens</b></p>	<p>12-200'. A conifer native to western North America that features reddish shaggy bark and bright green needles. Water infrequently to develop drought tolerance. Full sun.</p>
	<p><b>Celosia argentea plumosa</b> <b>'Rose Gold'</b></p>	<p>3-4'. This stunning mix is the most unusual range of rose gold, blush, and champagne plumes that look as if they have been dusted with iridescent glitter. Full sun. Annual. NEW!</p>
	<p><b>Chinese Pistache</b> <b>Pistacia chinensis</b></p>	<p>Matures to 30-35'. Showy deciduous tree with a rounded, umbrella-like canopy of dark green, pinnate leaves. Turns brilliant colors of yellow, orange red come fall. Berries are a food source for birds. Tolerates a wide range of well-draining soil types, including clay. Drought tolerant. Full sun.</p>
	<p><b>Chrysanthemum</b> <b>Chrysanthemum morifolium</b> <b>'Peace'</b></p>	<p>2-3'. Prolific white, fluffy blooms with butter-yellow centers bloom late summer through fall. Excellent cut flower. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!</p>
	<p><b>Columbine</b> <b>Aquilegia sp.</b></p>	<p>1-2'. Columbine flowers have spurred blooms in beautiful colors. A magnet for butterflies/hummingbirds. Some deer/rabbit resistance. Part shade. Mildly toxic. Perennial.</p>
	<p><b>Columbine, Golden</b> <b>Aquilegia chrysantha</b></p>	<p>3-4'. Golden blooms with spurs up to 3" across with ferny foliage. Blooms late spring to summer. Pollinator plant. Some deer resistance. Full sun/part shade. Mildly toxic. Perennial.</p>
	<p><b>Columbine, Western</b> <b>Aquilegia canadensis</b></p>	<p>2-3' A NATIVE to California, ferny foliage is topped with striking red and yellow spurred blooms. Attracts hummingbirds. Grows best in moist partially-shady spots. Perennial. NEW!</p>




	<b>Coneflower, Purple</b> <b>Echinacea purpurea</b>	1-2'. Herbaceous NATIVE. Hardy, long-blooming and drought tolerant. Large daisy-like flowers of pink/purple with a large central disk or cone. Pollinator plant. Deer resistant. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Coneflower</b> <b>Echinacea purpurea 'Starlight'</b>	2-3'. 3" flowers have a skirt of carmine-rose ray petals held almost level around burnt-orange centers. Attracts pollinators. Deer resistant/drought tolerant. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Coneflower, Yellow</b> <b>Ratibida pinnata</b>	3-5'. This Midwest native has showy yellow blooms with brown centers on tall stems. Tolerant of clay soils. Attracts bees and butterflies. Drought tolerant. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Cosmos</b> <b>Cosmos bipinnatus 'Apricotta'</b>	3-3.5'. Lovely flowers start tangerine, turn rose. Some flowers have an extra layer of petals. Very productive. Cutting or deadheading will produce more flowers. Full sun. Annual.
	<b>Cosmos</b> <b>Cosmos bipinnatus 'Cupcakes Blush'</b>	3'. A light and airy pink-blushed bloom with some blooms having a tufted center. Easy to grow. Pinch when 8" tall to establish a more robust, branching plant. Make the cut at the base of the stem to encourage regrowth. Full sun. Annual.
	<b>Cosmos</b> <b>Cosmos bipinnatus 'Double Click Cranberries'</b>	3'. A beautiful mix of double-bloom cosmos in a deep cranberry color. Easy to grow. Pinch when 8" tall to establish a more robust, branching plant. Make the cut at the base of the stem to encourage regrowth. Full sun. Annual. NEW!
	<b>Cosmos</b> <b>Cosmos bipinnatus 'Double Dutch Rose'</b>	4'. Semi- to fully-double blooms in a ballerina pink color. Very productive. Cutting or deadheading will produce more flowers. Full sun. Annual.
	<b>Cosmos</b> <b>Cosmos bipinnatus 'Sea Shell Blend'</b>	4'. A blend of white, pink, rose, and crimson blossoms. Great for cut flowers or a naturalized area. They are drought tolerant once established. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. Full sun. Annual.
	<b>Coyote Mint</b> <b>Monardella villosa 'Russian River'</b>	1-2' NATIVE perennial shrub with fragrant mint scented leaves and lavender flowers. Drought tolerant. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	<b>Cranesbill</b> <b>Geranium x magnificum</b>	6-12". Groundcover with light-purple blossoms. Scented foliage turns reddish in fall. Stays neat. Deer/rabbit resistant. Full sun. Perennial.











	<b>Creeping Charlie, Variegated Glechoma hederacea</b>	3'. This vining plant has attractive white-and-green variegated leaves. Great in containers. Can be invasive in flower beds. Some deer resistance. Part shade best. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Dahlia Dahlia pinnata 'Black Forest Ruby'</b>	2-2.5'. 3.5" semi-double to double blooms in shades of scarlet to dark red stand out against dark nearly black foliage. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Daisy, Santa Barbara Erigeron karvinskianus</b>	1-2'. Trailing groundcover with small white-and-pink daisies. Flowers almost year-round. Good trailer over a wall or in pots. Deer-resistant/drought tolerant. Pollinator plant. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Daisy, Shasta Leucanthemum x superbum</b>	2-3'. White-flowered, easy to grow. Pollinator plant. Deer resistant and drought tolerant. Good cut flower. Spreads. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Daylily Hemerocallis</b>	12-18". Orange daylily. Tough, easy-to-grow, drought tolerant/heat tolerant. Good border plant. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Dogwood, Flowering Cornus sp.</b>	15-30'. Low branching deciduous small understory dogwood with showy white or pink flowers in spring and red fruit in late summer. Part shade.
	<b>Dogwood, Red Twig Cornus sericea 'Peter's Choice'</b>	6-12'. Deciduous NATIVE with smooth, dark-red shiny bark. Valued for their bright red stems and branches. Wonderful medium-sized tree. Full sun/part shade.
	<b>Dogwood, Red-twig, Variegated Cornus alba 'Elegantissima'</b>	6-8'. Variegated green-and-cream-colored leaves on bright red branches. Deciduous. Great accent plant with 4-season interest. Deer/rabbit resistant. Full/part sun. NEW!
	<b>Drumstick Flower Craspedia globosa 'Yellow Drumstick'</b>	2-2.5'. Silver grass-like leaves and bright yellow globes. Fabulous in flower arrangements. Drought tolerant. Pollinator plant. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Elderberry Sambucus nigra 'Thundercloud'</b>	6-8'. Highly ornamental, this lacy shrub is prized for its purple leaves and pink umbels that flower in spring, followed by edible berries. Full sun. All parts of the plant are toxic except ripe berries. Deciduous. NEW!











	<b>Euonymus sp.</b>	6'. A native of Japan. Leaves are evergreen or semi-evergreen; fall berries are long-lasting. Tolerates a wide variety of soils. Full sun/part shade.
	<b>False Fennel Ridolfia segetum 'Goldspray'</b>	2-3'. False fennel or Ridolfia is one of the very best fillers for bouquets. Its 5" broad umbels of yellow-lacy flowers bloom throughout summer. Pollinator plant. Full sun. Annual. NEW!
	<b>Fig, Black Mission Ficus carica 'Mission'</b>	15-30' tall and wide fig tree. Very long-lived deciduous tree. Tolerant of poor non-acidic soil. Very sweet, delicious fruit. Two harvests per year. Good for eating fresh or preserving. Best grown against a south-facing wall. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	<b>Fig, Brown Turkey Ficus carica 'Brown Turkey'</b>	15-30' tall and wide. Very long-lived deciduous tree. Tolerant of poor soil but not acidic. Fruit starts green and when ripe turns brownish-purple. Protect from freezes but was bred to be more cold hardy than other figs. Two harvests per year. Good for eating and preserving. Use horticultural oils for pests. Deer resistant. Full sun.
	<b>Forget-Me-Not (Blue), Chinese Cynoglossum amabile 'Firmament'</b>	1-2'. These sky-blue dainty flowers atop attractive green foliage are irresistible and bloom all spring. Deer resistant. Reseeds. Great for bouquets. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Forget-Me-Not (Pink), Chinese Cynoglossum amabile 'Mystic Pink'</b>	18". These pink soft delicate flowers atop attractive green foliage are irresistible and bloom all spring. The upright growth habit adds vertical elegance to your garden. Filler in bouquets. Deer resistant. Reseeds. Full sun/part shade. Perennial.
	<b>Gayfeather Liatris spicata 'Floristan Violet'</b>	3-4'. Spikes of fluffy violet-purple flowers attract pollinators. Gayfeathers are hardy plants which tolerate poor soil, heat, humidity, and severe winter weather. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Geranium, Rose Scented Pelargonium graveolans</b>	1-2'. Beautiful rose-scented geranium is a wonderful plant that can be grown indoors or outside with some winter protection. Drought tolerant/deer resistant. Full sun/afternoon shade. Half-hardy perennial.
	<b>Germander, Dwarf Teucrium chamaedrys 'Nanum'</b>	1'. Attractive spreading groundcover sports fragrant leaves and showy purple flowers in summer. Can be trimmed into a short hedge. Drought tolerant/deer resistant. Full sun/part shade. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Germander, Iranian Teucrium hircanicum</b>	2-3'. Purple spikes of flowers rise above leathery-green aromatic bushy foliage for a pleasing addition to the perennial bed. Deer resistant and drought tolerant and un-fussy about soil type. Full sun/part shade. Perennial. NEW!

	<p><b>Geum</b> <b>Geum chilense 'Red Dragon'</b></p>	<p>2'. Dark-green rosettes of foliage and fiery-scarlet double blooms, this Geum is beautiful in masses mixed with shorter grasses in informal cottage gardens. Full sun/part shade. Perennial. NEW!</p>
	<p><b>Goldenrod, Dwarf</b> <b>Solidago nemoralis</b></p>	<p>6"-2'. Sprays of attractive yellow blooms in late summer. One of the smallest species of goldenrod, this North American native is well suited for backyard gardens. Attracts pollinators. Drought tolerant. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!</p>
	<p><b>Grape, Roger's Red</b> <b>Vitus 'Roger's Red'</b></p>	<p>20-40' tall and wide. A vigorous hybrid between the NATIVE and European grape. Deciduous. Prized for its flaming red fall foliage. Pollinator plant, attracts birds and wildlife. Full sun.</p>
	<p><b>Grass, Blue Eyed</b> <b>Sisyrinchium bellum</b></p>	<p>1-2' tall perennial herb with grass-like leaves and charming true blue to purple-blue flowers. Blossoms from January to July, then dies back in late summer. Tolerates some summer dryness. A wonderful addition to any garden. Deer resistant. Full/part sun. NEW!</p>
	<p><b>Grass, Blue Fescue</b> <b>Festuca glauca</b></p>	<p>1'. Blue ornamental perennial grass tolerates a wide range of sites and conditions. "No fuss" plant. To clean, comb the dead blades out with your fingers. Deer resistant. Full sun. Perennial.</p>
	<p><b>Grass, Blue Grama</b> <b>Bouteloua gracilis</b></p>	<p>12-20". Grass with very cool eyelash flowers. Drought tolerant/deer resistant. Host plant for skipper butterflies. Pollinator plant. Full sun. Perennial.</p>
	<p><b>Grass, Chinese Silver</b> <b>Miscanthus sinensis</b></p>	<p>4-6'. Fabulous grass, easy to grow. This is a specimen grass that has a vase shape and wonderful winter color. Drought tolerant, deer/rabbit resistant, usually disease and pest free. Full sun. Perennial.</p>
	<p><b>Grass, Karl Foerster</b> <b>Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Karl Foerster'</b></p>	<p>5-6'. A columnar grass. Wonderful grouped for structural interest and movement of the lovely wheat-colored seed heads. Deer/rabbit resistant, winter interest. This is an easy, low-maintenance plant. Full sun/partial shade. Perennial.</p>
	<p><b>Hibiscus (Sunset)</b> <b>Abelmoschus manihot</b></p>	<p>4-6'. A unique plant with amazing lemon yellow flowers/burgundy eyes. Gorgeous!!! Not a real hibiscus, related to okra. Full sun/partial shade. Annual.</p>
	<p><b>Hibiscus, Red-Leaf</b> <b>Hibiscus acetosella 'Mahogany Splendor'</b></p>	<p>3-5' hibiscus unlike any other. Our favorite foliage plant with stiff upright large Japanese like burgundy maple-like leaves. Great for flower arrangements. Drought tolerant. Full sun gives best foliage color. A Master Gardener favorite. Annual.</p>

	<b>Horehound, Scallop Shell</b> <i>Marrubium supinum</i>	1-2'. This Mediterranean plant is grown for its unusual curly, fuzzy gray-green leaves and purple flowers. It needs no summer water. Deer resistant. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Hydrangea, Oakleaf</b> <i>Hydrangea quercifolia</i>	6-8'. Beautiful deciduous flowering shrub with 3 seasons of interest. In spring, long-lasting large clusters of flowers begin white and slowly change to creamy pink. Fall color leaves turn orange/red. Part shade is best. Toxic.
	<b>Indigo, False</b> <i>Baptisia australis</i>	3.5'. Lavender-blue flowers late spring to summer. Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies, and pollinators. Deer resistant/drought tolerant. Full sun/part shade. Toxic. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Iris, Pacific Coast</b> <i>Iris douglasiana</i>	1-2'. Spreading rhizomatous NATIVE evergreen perennial with lovely white iris flowers with yellow markings. Sword-shaped leaves. Borders, rock gardens. Tough plant. Full sun/part shade. Perennial.
	<b>Iris, Siberian</b> <i>Iris siberica</i>	1-2'. Blue showy flowers top strappy green leaves which stay attractive after the flowers have faded. Long-lived plants, deer/rabbit resistant. Full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Joe-Pye Weed</b> <i>Eutrochium fistulosum</i>	4-6'. A pollinator magnet shrub/back of the border perennial. Needs medium moisture to establish, then becomes more drought tolerant. Big pink dome-shaped umbels. Bumblebees & butterflies love this plant. Full sun/part shade. A Master Gardener favorite.
	<b>Jupiter's Beard</b> <i>Centranthus ruber</i>	2-3'. Easy to grow. Bright reddish-pink, long- blooming flower clusters. Drought tolerant, deer/rabbit resistant. Can be invasive. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Lamb's Ears, Large Leaf</b> <i>Stachys byzantina</i> 'Helene Von Stein'	10". Large-leaved groundcover. Leaves are fuzzy, soft, and silver. Great for dry areas. Black walnut tolerant. Deer-resistant/drought tolerant. Tough plant that spreads. Full sun/part shade. Perennial.
	<b>Lavender Cotton</b> <i>Santolina chamaecyparissus</i> 'Nana'	1.5'. This dense, mounding, woody evergreen shrub has small bright yellow blooms in summer atop silvery gray-green foliage. A tough plant, it requires only very low water and is deer resistant. Full sun. NEW!
	<b>Lavender, 'Munstead'</b> <i>Lavandula angustifolia</i> 'Munstead'	12-18". This compact lavender sports brilliant bluish-purple flowers on 18" flower spikes. Blue-grey aromatic foliage is evergreen and loves a hot dry climate. Deer/rabbit resistant. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!










	<b>Lavender, English Tall</b> <i>Lavandula angustifolia</i>	1-3'. Lavender-blue flowers late spring, well into summer. Fragrant flowers may be dried for sachets/potpourris. Grows best in well-drained soil in full sun. Perennial.
	<b>Lemon Balm</b> <i>Melissa officinalis</i>	2-3'. This perennial herb has lemon-scented leaves and small white or pink flowers. Prized for its essential oil, use in teas. Can spread. Good in containers. Attracts bees. Drought tolerant/deer resistant. Full sun. NEW!
	<b>Lenten Rose, Pink</b> <i>Helleborus orientalis</i>	12-18". Early blooming, fabulous easy-care pink flowers. Deer resistant. Pollinator plant. Nice cut flowers. Full/part shade. Toxic. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Lenten Rose, Red</b> <i>Helleborus orientalis</i>	12-18". Early blooming, fabulous easy-care rose-red flowers. Deer resistant. Pollinator plant. Nice cut flowers. Full sun/part shade. Toxic. Tough perennial.
	<b>Lenten Rose, White</b> <i>Helleborus orientalis</i>	12-18". Early blooming, fabulous easy-care white flowers. Deer resistant. Pollinator plant. Nice cut flowers. Full sun/part shade. Toxic. Tough perennial.
	<b>Lewisia</b> <i>Lewisia cotyledon</i> 'Elise Rosy Pink'	8". Rosy-pink Lewisia opens in shades of pale whitish-pink flowers kissed with a gentle blush. Perfect for tucking into rock walls, gravel beds, and containers. Full sun. Perennial. NEW!
	<b>Lilac, Common</b> <i>Syringa vulgaris</i>	8-12'. Deciduous shrub with amazing fragrant flowers that bloom in the spring. Lovely purple color. Prune after bloom. Full sun.
	<b>Lily, Calla</b> <i>Zantedeschia aethiopica</i>	3'. Elegant white trumpet-shaped flowers atop vibrant green foliage. Grows easily in zones 8-10. In colder zones, it can be taken indoors, perhaps in a sunny garage window. Deer/rabbit resistant. Full/part sun. Perennial.
	<b>Lily, Cape Bugle</b> <i>Watsonia borbonica</i>	5'. Beautiful white tubular flowers look magnificent atop tall stems that bloom from spring to summer. A native to South Africa, it thrives in zones 8-10 in full sun. Perennial.

	<b>Milkweed, Narrowleaf</b> <b>Asclepias fascicularis</b>	4-6'. Nevada County NATIVE milkweed. Sweet-scented flowers with long, narrow leaves. Extremely drought tolerant once established.
