IMPORTANT INFO

PRE-CAMP PREPARATIONS

WHAT TO BRING

- Pajamas, Clothes for 4 days, and Costumes
- Closed-Toe Shoes, Crocs don't Count!
- Swimsuit, Water Shoes, & Towel
- Toiletries, Sunscreen, & Bug Spray
- Sleeping Bag, Blanket, & Pillow
- Prescriptions (Must turn into Staff at arrival)
- Water Bottle, Flashlight, & Cabin Decorations

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Food, Drinks, Alcohol, or Drugs
- Weapons (Pocket knives included)
- Firearms, fireworks, or matches
- Cellphones or other electronic devices
- Cigarettes or other E-Cig devices
- Money

DRESS CODE

Following items are prohibited at camp:

- Backless, Tube, Halter, One Shoulder, & Spaghetti Strap Tops
- Visible Undergarments, Midriff & Cleavage
- Overly Ripped Jeans & Ripped/Short Shorts
- Inappropriate Logos
- Flip Flops, Open-Toed Shoes*
