

Nevada County 4-H Requirements to Exhibit at Fair

Purpose:

This document outlines the Nevada County 4-H Requirements for 4-H youth to Exhibit at Fair for program year 2026 – 2027. All requirements listed align to the 4-H Steps to Success policy.

Requirements*

- Be a Member in Good Standing
- Complete total hours for project completion as determined by Project Leader in their Annual Project Plan, (minimum of 6 hours) spanning from September 1st to the Monday of Fair week in the current program year.
- Up-to-date Annual Project Report (APR) Form submitted to project leader by Friday of the week before Fair. *Note: If a youth member fails to satisfy this requirement by Friday of the week before fair, their fair eligibility will be revoked, they will not be allowed to participate in the fair as a 4-H member, and they will not be allowed to bring that exhibit to the fair.* Primary members: youth aged 5 to 8 years, do not complete the APR.
- Meet requirements as set by the fair.

REQUIREMENTS SET BY COUNTY 4-H STAFF**

- Complete the steps to become a Member in Good Standing by December 1st of the current program year.
