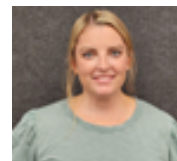

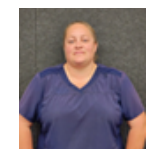

PINEAPPLE UPSIDE-DOWN CAKE

Tami Walker Reeds-Creek 4-H

1 dozen walnut halves
1/4 cup butter
1/2 cup brown sugar
No. 2 can sliced or chunk pineapple
1-1/4 cup flour
1-1/2 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup sugar
1/3 cup fat
1/2 cup milk
1 egg
1 teaspoon vanilla

Melt butter in pan, spread with brown sugar. Drain pineapple, arrange on sugar with walnuts. Sift together flour, baking powder, salt and sugar, in a bowl.

Add remaining ingredients. Beat for two minutes. Pour over fruit - sugar mixture, and bake in oven at 350° for 35-40 minutes. Use 8" or 9" square baking pan.

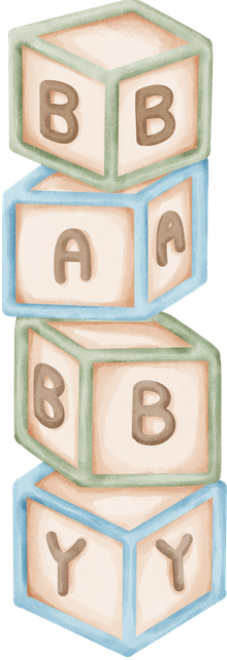

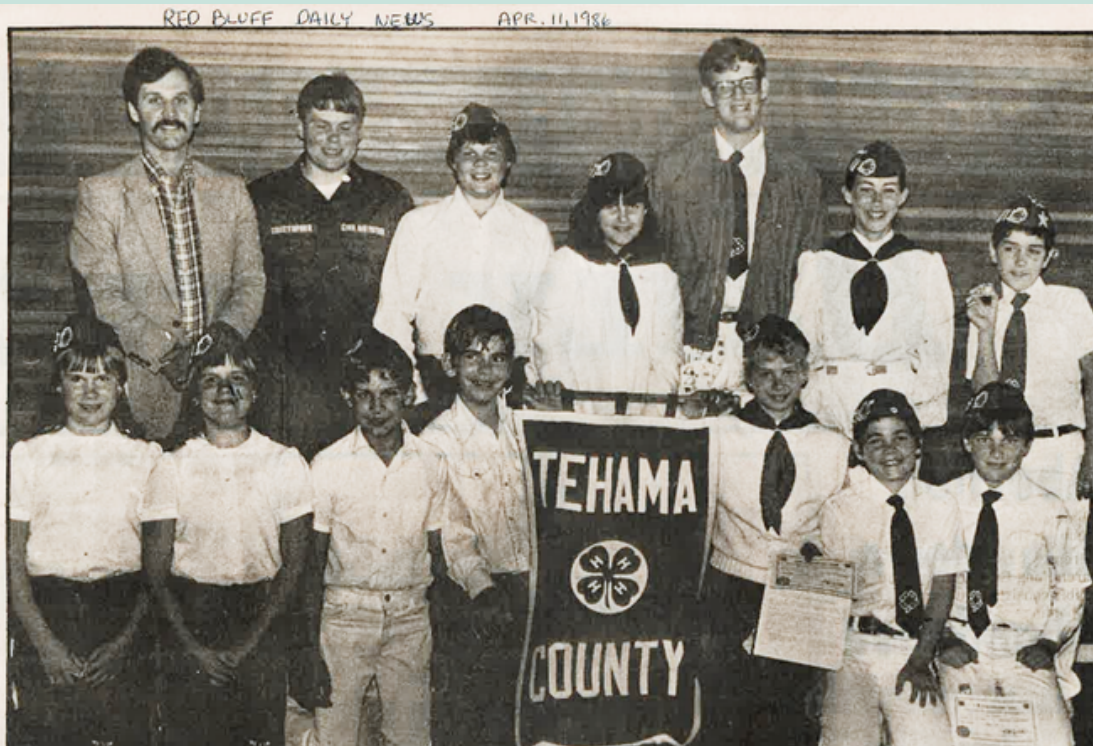
