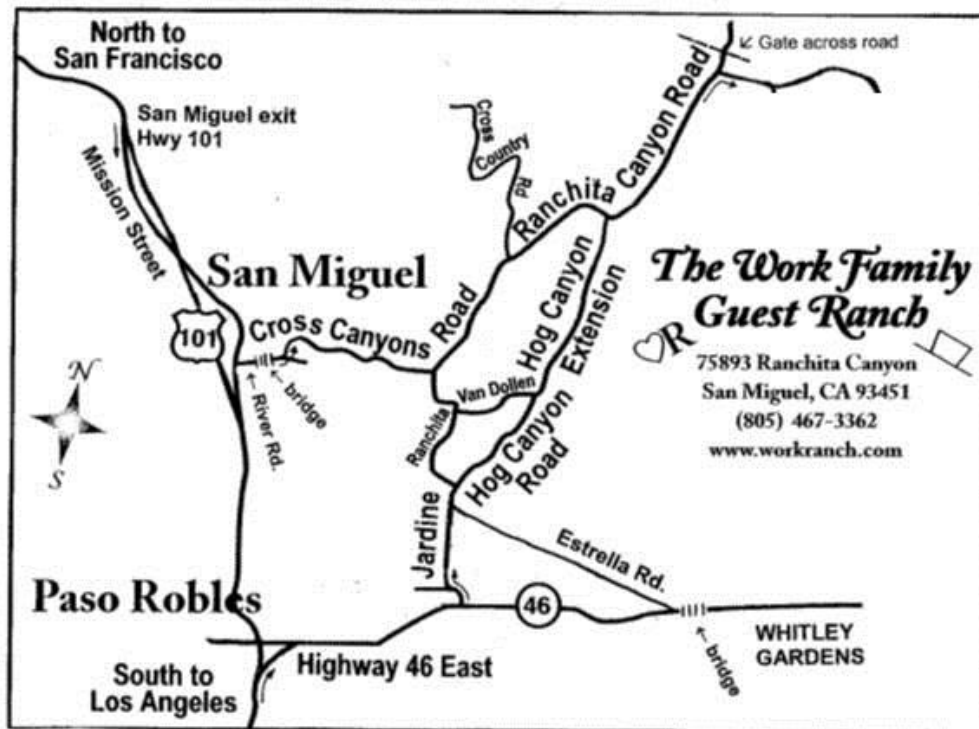




Field Trip to Observe Road Management on Ranch Lands, San Luis Obispo County October 22, 2012



Three field trips are being held in conjunction with the webinar series on rural roads of California (see <http://ucanr.org/roadswebinar>). This field trip will be to a working ranch in Southern Monterey County located near San Miguel (see map, below). Participants will observe and discuss the rancher's solutions to providing stream crossings and managing road runoff. They will also observe the installation of a new road. Road-related water quality issues will be addressed.
