

HARDWOOD TREES OF THE SOUTHERN CASCADES

Leaves deeply lobed

Veins branch off the mid-vein

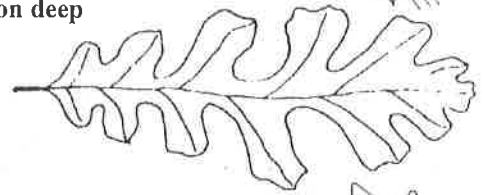
lobes pointed

Black oak - found among mixed conifers
(Quercus kelloggii)



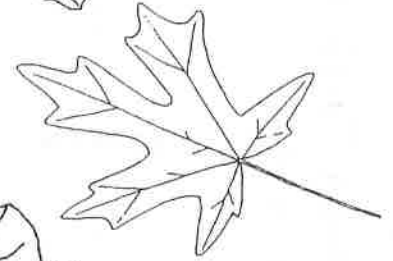
lobes rounded

Valley oak - found on deep valley soils
(Quercus lobata)



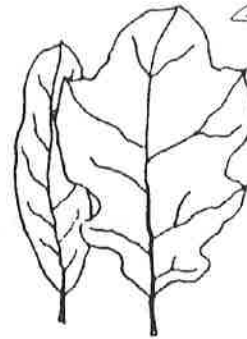
Palmate venation with rounded tips

Big leaf maple - found along streams
(Acer macrophyllum)



Leaves blue-green and dull on both sides

Blue oak - found in the foothills <3000 ft.
(Quercus douglasii)

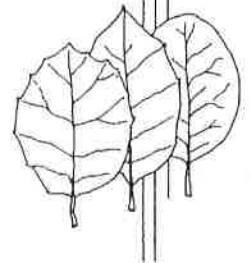


Leaves unlobed or prickly

Leaves shiny on top

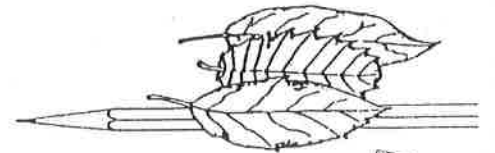
leaves shiny on bottom

(Quercus wislizenii)



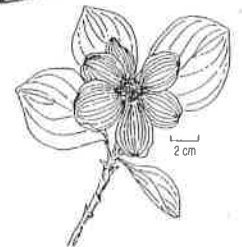
leaves dull on bottom

(Quercus chrysolepis)



Smooth leaves, showy white flowers

Dogwood - found in understory of conifer forest
(Cornus nuttallii)



Coarse-toothed leaves, straight veins

White Alder - found along perennial streams
(Alnus rhombifolia)
