

Glenn County 4-H Horse Identification Registration Form

Members must submit the Horse Registration Certificate to the UCCE Office in Glenn County at least 120 days prior to the 4-H horse show. Filling out the form is the responsibility of the 4-H member. A horse may be used by more than one member of the same immediate family, but at California Fairs horses owned leased as a joint project may only be shown by one designated exhibitor at an individual show.

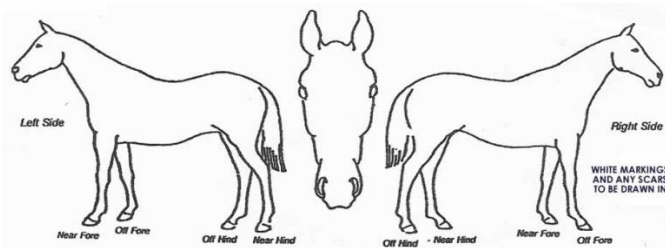
