### 4-H Adult Volunteer Re-Appointment Process

<b>STEP #1</b>	Submit 4-H adult volunteer application packet to UCCE Office or process online enrollment at: <a href="https://ca.4honline.com">https://ca.4honline.com</a> . Create a profile, enter all required information, and submit. 4hOnline adult status will show as pending until all steps listed below are complete.
<b>STEP #2</b>	Complete required “2020-21 California Returning Volunteers Training” in eXtension* (go to <a href="https://campus.extension.org/enrol/index.php?id=1868">https://campus.extension.org/enrol/index.php?id=1868</a> .) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Introduction to this Course (10 min)</li><li>b. Abuse Risk Management for Volunteers (15 min)</li><li>c. Reporting Child Abuse &amp; Neglect (40)</li></ul> * Note: The Enrollment Key can be requested by clicking on this link: <a href="http://ucanr.edu/survey/survey.cfm?surveynumber=20474">http://ucanr.edu/survey/survey.cfm?surveynumber=20474</a> . Glenn County Volunteer Enrollment Key is “Glenn”
<b>STEP #3</b>	Complete any additional trainings required by your county. Glenn County may have a new leader and returning leader training. More information will be available soon and sent out to all leaders.  *Please call the UCCE Office at (530) 865-1107 for more information or to receive additional training material.
<b>STEP #4</b>	The application is reviewed by the County Director. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. If approved, notification of your 4-H adult volunteer appointment will be sent from 4hOnline and you will receive a letter of approval from the County Director along with your 2020-2021 Adult Volunteer Appointment Card.</li><li>b. If there are any limitations on the appointment, they will be included in a letter sent from the County Director.</li><li>c. If not approved, a letter will be sent to the applicant from the County Director.</li></ul>
