We will be accepting entries for the Glenn County 4-H Virtual Showcase held, **Monday, June 6- 30, 2022**. Your entries can be submitted by a short video or pictures and a short paragraph. See details about your submission below.

WHEN? Every entry submitted throughout the week will be presented on our website and social media every Friday until **Friday, July 1, 2022**. We will combine **all entries** received the following week and showcase them on our website.

WHO? Any Glenn County 4-H Member that has completed their project, including:

- Be a member in good standing,
- Complete a minimum of six hours of project instruction or more as required by the project leader in project area.

HOW? Call the UCCE Office at (530) 865-1107 to complete the survey over the phone or complete the online survey with your 4-H division and project category. Online registration at:

- Show and tell us about your project in a short video (no more than 45 seconds long) and/or submit 2-3 pictures and include a short paragraph (prepared talk) about your project.
- Email your videos and/or picture entries to glenncounty4h@ucanr.edu or upload them to the survey.

Even though fair has passed, and your livestock project has been sold, you can still submit photos you may have and a paragraph about your project.

TIPS



What to show in your pictures/video of your animal:

- Some photo options would be side profile view, front view, back view, and top view.
- For a video, walk your animal, stop, and pose.
- Highlight your animal's best characteristics.
- Tell us what you like about your project in your paragraph/video and if there was something you could change, what would it be and why?

What to show in your pictures/video of your Quilting, Sewing, Arts & Crafts (ABA Project):

- Display your whole project in your photos and videos. Let us take a closer look at your detailed work.
- In your paragraph/video, tell us about your pattern, color scheme, why you made the choices you did and what was challenging.
- Capture your project and share with us what you have learned, what did you like most about this project and anything else you want us to know.

HELPFUL TOOLS

Some suggestions for your video prepared talk or paragraph...

Livestock/Animal

- Member's name, club, age and division.
- Project species and name of animal.
- Age of the animal.
- Tell us what you like most about your animal?
- What was your biggest challenge with your animal?
- What was the most valuable lesson you learned this year?
- Demonstrate how you show your animal.

ABA

- Member's name, club, age and division.
- Project type.
- What made you choose this design?
- What made you choose these colors?
- What did you learn this year?
- What do you like most about your project?
- Was this a challenging project for you? Why?
- What new skill did you learn?

RECORD BOOK

How can the Virtual Showcase count in my record book? You can choose from a few categories on your Personal Development Report (PDR) to capture this virtual event in your record books.

1. #2. 4-H Project Skill Activities – Exhibited project in the Glenn County 4-H Virtual Showcase
2. #3. Events Attended – Glenn County 4-H Virtual Showcase
3. #6. Communication Skills – Prepared talk and video and/or prepared project story and photo submission for the Glenn County 4-H Virtual Showcase

***You can only count activities in one category, except for an event attended and honors and recognition.**

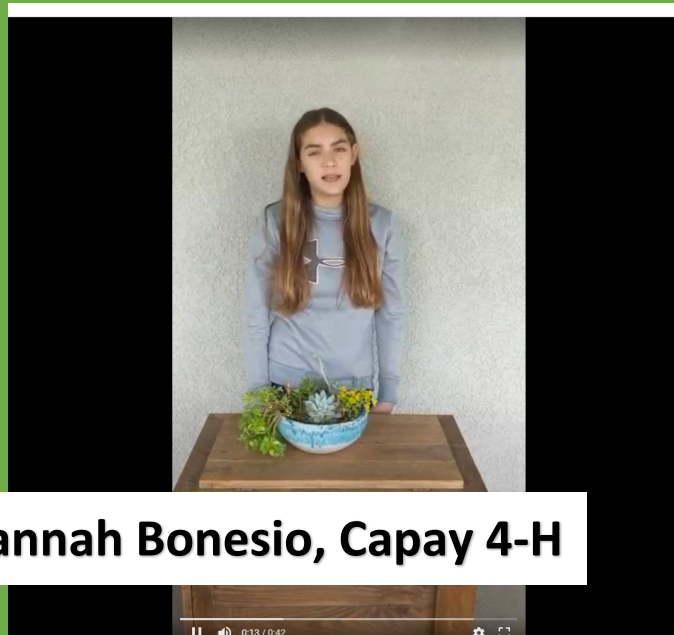
