If you have attended an alternative event to meet these requirements, please let us know which event you have attended by emailing [glenncounty4h@ucanr.edu](mailto:glenncounty4h@ucanr.edu) or by calling the UCCE Office at (530) 865-1107.

- Livestock exhibitors must attend the Glenn County 4-H Livestock Challenge/Field Day Event. Alternative events are the CSU 4-H Livestock Evaluation, CSU Chico State Livestock Field Days, or a related livestock event from a neighboring county.
- ABA exhibitors must attend Glenn County 4-H ABA Extravaganza Event. Alternative events are the Glenn County 4-H Quilt Show, Fashion Revue, or a related ABA event from a neighboring county.
