Nominations must be presented to the UCCE Office by **Monday, August 14, 2023**, to be placed on the voting ballot. The voting will take place at the normally scheduled Council Meeting on **Monday, August 21, 2023**, at 7:00 p.m. at the UCCE Office or via Zoom.
