

Glenn County 4-H Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Anything But Animals (ABA) Award Guidelines and Application 2023-2024

(Deadline is Monday, July 1, 2024)

Goal and Philosophy of the Award:

The Glenn County 4-H Program annually sponsors pins and medals for outstanding participants in the following projects:

Archery, Arts & Crafts, Baking & Bread Making, Cake Decorating, Cooking, Clothing & Textiles, Food & Nutrition, Painting, Jr. Master Gardener, General Engineering/ Mechanical Science, Legos, Ornamental Horticulture, Photography, Outdoor Adventures, Quilting, Scrapbooking, Sports Shooting, Veterinary Science, and Welding.

Eligibility:

You may apply for an award in more than one project area as long as you have enrolled and participated in that 4-H project throughout the program year.

- Primary Division (5-8 years old by Dec. 31, 2023, for the 2023-2024 4-H program year)
- Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Division (9-18 years old by Dec. 31, 2023, for the 2023-2024 4-H program year.)
- Be currently enrolled in the Glenn County 4-H Program.
- Be currently enrolled in an ABA Project (4-H Foods & Nutrition, Cooking, Sewing, etc.)

Points are earned for participation in county 4-H events. Primary members (ages 5 -8) must have participated in 2 of the 3 events. Ten points are earned for participation (i.e., exhibiting, judging, emceeing, creating judging classes, etc.) in each county event. These county events are Quilt Show, Food Fiesta, Arts & Creative Skills Day, ABA Judging Day, County Presentation Day, and the Glenn County Fair Still Exhibits.

Awards:

Of those earning 20 points or more in a project, the top 10% are eligible to receive a special medal. The top-scoring person with 35 points or more in each project in the Senior, Intermediate, and Junior Divisions receives a medallion. The Primary Division members who meet the requirements will receive a rosette ribbon. Awards are presented at the Star Awards Event in the Fall.
