CENTRAL YOUTH SUMMIT

Funding Level:

MEMBERS: Eight awards of 1/2 the conference fee.

ADULTS: Full cost for the number of adults required by the conference quota.

MEMBERS:

- 1. Meet conference age eligibility
- 2. Completed one year in 4-H at the time of conference.
- 3. Submit completed Annual Project Report or Record Book from at least the previous year.
- 4. Available only once per member.

ADULTS:

- 1. Meet conference age eligibility
- 2. Be an official 4-H leader fingerprinted and orientation completed.

CALIFORNIA FOCUS

Funding Level:

MEMBERS: No CA Focus scholarship will be distributed – Members expected to fundraise for full amount

LEADERS: Pay for one adult or split 50/50 for two.

If three adults required, give \$200 each.
