### **PRIMARY MEMBERS**

**Primary Members** – Must be 5 years old or in kindergarten by December 31 of the program year. Youth enrolling or turning nine after December 31 must participate as a Primary Member until the end of the program year.

Primary members may ***not*** enroll in large animal livestock projects and shooting sports. Approved primary member animal projects are dogs, rabbits, rats, cats, poultry, cavies, mice, embryology, bees, entomology, marine science, pygmy & Nigerian dwarf goats and therapeutic animal projects.

Primary Members are not to be put in competitive situations in the 4-H program and will receive **participation recognition only**. Primary members may display their indoor exhibits on their club table.
