However, it is understood that a situation may arise that would cause you to need to miss a required event/activity. If this occurs, you must provide written documentation to the Ambassador Advisor stating the reason for your requested absence PRIOR to the event/activity in order to receive approval to miss the event/activity.

Term of Service:

❖ July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021

Requirements:

- Develop Ambassador Plan of Action (as a team)
- Plan and Participate in Community (Kings County) Outreach Activities to Promote Kings County 4-H and/or Ambassador Service Learning Project – 3 minimum per Ambassador
- Plan and Decorate for Kings County 4-H Achievement Night
- Membership on Kings County 4-H County-wide Event Planning Committee AND attendance at event – 1 minimum per Ambassador
- Attend Ambassador Meetings – minimum 80% attendance per Ambassador
- Submit an “Ambassador Spotlight” article for the Kings County 4-H Youth Talk – 1 minimum per Ambassador
- Ambassador representation at Leaders Council Meetings
- Attend State Leadership Conference – Council will pay for you to attend SLC for your 1st attendance; scholarships (50%) are available to attend additional years
- Complete Exit Application and Interview – you will discuss your leadership growth and development, highlights from your year of service, and any suggestions for improvements to the Ambassador program.
- Other duties as assigned by advisor

Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, you will be awarded the County Ambassador Rank.
