## YQCA Training

In-Person YQCA training for ALL Youth Livestock Exhibitors— age 9 to 19 exhibiting at the Lassen County Fair.

YQCA must be complete by anyone between the ages of 9-19 for both market and breeding exhibitors. The only ones who are excluded are those showing just in the dog or cavy division!

## WHEN: WEDNESDAY, APRIL 24, 2024 \* 6:30 TO 7:30 PM \* JENSEN HALL

Completing this course will earn you the YQCA certificate which is required to show livestock at the Lassen County Fair. Cost of the course is \$3.00 which must be paid on-line; see instructions below.

Register for the course at YQCA (if possible, before April 24). Go to weblink: <a href="https://yqcaprogram.org/">https://yqcaprogram.org/</a>

- Sign in to your YQCA account OR create a new account if you don't have one.
- Once you are logged into your YQCA account, click the Purchase Course button
- Select any **Instructor-led** course for a Junior, Intermediate, or Senior age group. Do NOT select Novice. The instructor-led courses cost \$3.
- When you go to Check Out, select California from the state menu. Then scroll through the list of courses and select the one for Lassen County at Jensen Hall on April 24, 2024.
- Finish checking out by paying for the course on-line.

Download your certificate from the YQCA website.

Once you have completed the course, and we have a record of your attendance, you will be able to download your certificate from the YQCA website.

New this year!! There is the option of taking an online test. You can only take the test once. You must answer 50 questions with at least 40 correct. If you pass, you do not have to take the training. Just pay the fee to print your certificate. For more information, go to the website.

Include a copy of your YQCA certificate with your market livestock fair entry form.

We strongly encourage you to pre-register for the course. However, if you don't pre-register there will be a short window of time – a few days - to register after you attend the course so that you can still receive your certificate.
