Suggested Procedure for Club Evaluation:

1. Hold meeting with all leaders in club to review record books and evaluate the year's program.
2. Sign and place seals in each record book
3. On a separate piece of paper write constructive, encouraging comments to the record book owner. **NEVER** write in the record book.
4. Encourage members to apply for County Medalist selection. Add a completed record book evaluation sheet and be sure the book is in the 4-H Office by the due date.
5. Encourage the Club Reporter, Secretary, Treasurer, Historian, and Newsletter to submit their officer books for county awards evaluation. The books should be turned in to the 4-H office by the due date.
6. Review application for seal for club charter (Program Planning Guide).
