Steps to Success to Show and/or Sell an Animal at the Fair, or Represent Placer County 4-H at State Fair Horse Shows

Listed below are the additional County requirements in accordance with the 4-H Steps to Success:

- Eligibility to Show and/or sell an animal at the fair
- Represent Placer County 4-H at State Fair Horse Shows
 1. **Must be enrolled in 4-H and any market animal projects by county due date - November 30, 2019*.**

2. ~~Participate in a minimum one of the following Countywide Activities or Events:~~ (dates & events subject to change)** Requirement removed for the 2019-2020 4-H year ONLY due to limited countywide event offerings.

Achievement Night 2019 (held in June 2019)	Presentation Day 2020 (February)

3. Submit a 4-H Record Book in paper format or a printed Online Record Book, which must include:

Personal Development Report	Project Report form completed and signed by Project Leader for each project.
My 4-H Story	If a Jr./Teen Leader, the completed Jr./Teen Leadership Development Report form.

4. Attend 80% of animal project meetings. Animal projects require more hours for follow-up support.
 - After two misses, absences must be made up.
 - You have 60 days to complete make up meetings.
 - Make-up must be pre-approved and meeting make-up form must be signed off by the Project Leader.
5. Returning members must attend 80% of all Club Meetings held within the club year. First year members only count 80% of club meetings after enrolling with club.
 - After two misses, absences must be made up.
 - You have 60 days to complete make up.
 - Make-up must be pre-approved and meeting make-up form must be signed off by the Community Club Leader.
6. If you add or drop a project, or make any other changes in your enrollment, you must make the change in your 4hOnline family account.
7. Youth must complete the animal ethics course yearly and print proof of completion and submit to the fair(s) that they are participating in. <http://yqca.org/>
8. Participate in a workday for each fair that youth are registered to sell/show in.
