BACKGROUND: Laura D. Hulbert and Neil F. Hulbert, now both deceased, were strong supporters of youth activities and especially respected the young people who were involved in the 4-H Program. They bequeathed a substantial amount of money to be used for awards to youth who had been outstanding participants in the 4-H Program. The first awards were given in 1994. **This year's awards in the amount of \$2,500 each will be given to one male, one female, and three additional awards open to either male or female.**

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION: All youth must comply with the following criteria in order to apply for the award.

- Applicant must be a student in Placer County, be at least 14 years old, and not yet 19 by December 31st of the selection year.
- Applicant must currently be enrolled in the Placer County 4-H program.
- Applicant may not have received this award in prior years.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Read through the Application Process completely. All documents listed must be included in the Application Packet and submitted together.

- **APPLICATION:** Applicant must complete the current Application Form (not an old form).
- **ESSAY:** Write a short essay, typed, not more than 2 pages double-spaced. Topic - "How has 4-H enriched your youth education & communication skills?"
- **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** *Letters of recommendation from three persons must be received by the due date to accompany the application. At least one letter should be from a school teacher, principal, or counselor, and one should be from an adult 4-H leader. Each letter must be **EMAILED or MAIL** by the person(s) submitting those letters **NOT** the applicants.*
- **TRANSCRIPT:** Applicant must submit a current transcript of grades.
- **COMPLETED Cover Sheet, Application, Essay, Transcript, and three Recommendation Letters must be received at the 4-H office by Friday, May 7, 2021. Items will not be accepted separately, except for the letters of recommendation which **MUST** be received by due date.**
- **Interviews, either through Zoom or phone, will be held Saturday, May 22, 2021 (no exceptions) starting at 9:00 a.m. You will be contacted with your interview time.**

SELECTION PROCESS: A committee of five community-based persons who are currently not involved directly with the 4-H program or related to the member-applicant will make the selection of recipients based on the following:

- Outstanding personal involvement in civic and community activities.
- Outstanding personal involvement in school activities.
- Outstanding involvement and leadership in 4-H related activities.
- Outstanding record of collaboration and cooperation with diverse groups and individuals.
- Satisfactory record of academic achievement.

SELECTION OF EVALUATORS:

- The evaluators should not be currently enrolled as 4-H leaders and should represent a variety of community-based organizations, groups, business, or schools.
- Recommendations will be submitted to the 4-H Community Education Specialist who will ascertain that all proposed evaluators meet the requirements of non-involvement with program or applicants.
- Evaluators will be approved by the County Director.
