Stages of Root Growth



Newly Planted



6 Months to 1 Year



3 Years

Even drought tolerant species need consistent watering when newly planted to get their root systems established.

PROPER WATERING TIP

- Less frequent, but long and deep watering sessions are more effective than frequent, shallow waterings.
 - This encourages deeper, stronger root growth.
 - Deep root systems will have access to more moisture, letting the plant go longer between waterings.
