Time commitment: One semester to one year.
Responsible to: Santa Clara County 4-H Youth Development Program Representative.
Responsibilities: Teaching the 4-H Computer Science Pathways Program (CS Program) once a week.

Qualifications:

- ✿ Desire and ability to work with elementary school aged children, provide feedback, encouragement and mentoring.
- ✿ Strong communication and interpersonal skills. Willingness and ability to work as part of a team.
- ✿ Openness to working with diverse populations.
- ✿ Strong organizational skills.
- ✿ Time commitment 2 hour per week, (1 for planning activities and 1 hour to facilitate program).
- ✿ Enthusiasm for the project and an openness to learn.

Specific tasks:

- ✿ Attend to CS Pathways training
- ✿ Implement the pre and post-surveys with students at predetermined dates, and submit surveys to 4-H YDP Representative.
- ✿ Come prepared to the weekly CS Pathways sessions.
- ✿ Provide coaching to students, facilitate the reflection process, and establish mutual learning relationships with youth.
- ✿ Participate in a program evaluation with the 4-H YDP Representative at the end of the implementation of the program.
- ✿ Hands-on experience working with elementary school aged students.
