#### **EASIER - GREAT FOR BEGINNERS**

Interpretive Reading – Introduce a passage from a book, read the passage and review it

Demonstration – How to do something while showing how to do it

Cultural Arts - Play music, individual dance or dramatic reading

## NOT HARD - FEELING CONFIDENT

Illustrated Talk – How to do something just talking about it

Educational Display Talk - Convey/teach a message about a topic with visual aids

Informative Prepared Speech - Convey/teach a message about a topic without visual aids

Persuasive Prepared Speech - Discuss both sides of a topic & persuade one side is the best

Science or Engineering - Create knowledge using hypothesis, testable prediction
