Key Factors that Influence Agritourism

- 1. Preserve Agriculture Itself
- 2. Well Organized Agriculture Community
- 3. General Plan inclusion of Ag and Water Elements
- 4. Zoning Code inclusion of 'value added' activities





Preserving Agriculture – Calaveras Co. Policy

- William Act continuation of program in absence of state subvention funds
- Conservation Easements
- 40 acre minimum parcel size without water and sewer
- Buffer Zoning descending population density between towns and ag lands
- Density Transfer consolidation of residences close to existing infrastructure

General Plan

- Ag must participate in the process
- Ag must develop and maintain a good working relationship with Co. Planning Dept.
- Include a Water Element
- Include an Agriculture Element
 - Agriculture writes the initial drafts





Zoning Code that Permits

- Value added processing on farm
 - bees wax candles health products
 - apples cider pies fritters
 - animals on farm processing
- Ag related activities
 - hay rides, petting zoos, farm tours etc.
- Events
 - weddings, concerts
- Agriculture Operations must remain central and integral to all agritourism operations
