## A little story about cooperation

After 8 years of negotiations, the City of Wheatland paid costs for our annexation, approx. \$70,000

In return, we agreed to collect a $5 \%$ surcharge on ticket sales at the farm, approx $\$ 20,000$ this year.

Half of the money collected is being set aside in a fund which we get to approve spending from.

We were able to eliminate zoning, water treatment, and fire safety issues; and hook up to city services. This will allow construction of public restrooms and
