



San Luis Obispo County 4-H Ambassador Program Coach

County Ambassador coaches will serve at least a one-year term, with eligibility for reappointment each year. Applicants will go through an application and selection process, and become a 4-H Adult Volunteer prior to serving as a coach. The application process for returning coaches is to submit intent to continue as a coach by the county deadline and go through the selection process.

Coach Role

The Coach's role is one of partnering and collaborating with County Ambassadors to implement best practices in positive youth development. Best practices include but are not limited to: setting group agreements at the beginning of the term as to how the group will function, facilitating educational components of the program and allowing youth to facilitate meetings and rotating leadership responsibility. A Coach should be flexible when working with County Ambassadors. Also, depending on the County's program, being a Coach could involve significant time commitments.

Coaches are expected to:

- Chaperone events and conferences when County Ambassadors are present.
- Partner with the County Ambassador team to coordinate meetings.
- Provide guidance to and collaborate with the County Ambassador team to ensure the team has clear, reasonable and attainable goals.
- Facilitate good communications between the coaches and the team, as well as between team members.
- Ensure that the team considers possible resources, including content experts, to accomplish the team's goals.
- Be knowledgeable of 4-H policies and ensure that the policies are followed. (The UCCE 4-H Program.
- Representative or 4-H Advisor is a resource for policy interpretations.)
