

## San Mateo/San Francisco 4-H County Ambassador Agreement

I understand that if I am selected as a County Ambassador, I may have many obligations, including some of the following:

- < Attend regular County Ambassador team meetings (usually monthly).
- < Attend County Ambassador retreats and other team building events.
- < Complete a year-long service learning project, which will benefit San Mateo/San Francisco County 4-H or community.
- < Attend monthly County Council meetings to give a County Ambassador report.
- < Attend and present a workshop at 4-H State Leadership Conference.
- < Attend and present a workshop at the Bay/Coast Youth Summit.
- < Assist at County and Area Events such as Presentation Day, Life Skills Festival, or Field Days.

*While attendance to every event or activity is not required, communication and follow-through on commits to specific events is expected.*

I realize that as a County Ambassador:

- < I must uphold the general guidelines and expectations of the County Ambassador Handbook.
- < I must follow the 4-H Code of Conduct whereby I must exhibit exemplary behavior, be respectful to all, not use any foul or abusive language or gestures, be a role model, and display a positive attitude. Possession or use of illegal drugs or alcohol, and theft or vandalism at any 4-H event or function is unacceptable behavior and may result in my suspension from the program.
- < I may have to reduce my involvement in other activities.
- < Extensive travel throughout the county/state will most likely be necessary.
- < The role is a working position of honor. I will represent my county in all that I do.

As a County Ambassador applicant, I realize that if I become a County Ambassador I will have the above obligations to fulfill to the best of my abilities. If I do not fulfill my responsibilities, I may be removed as a County Ambassador.
